SCRATCH POOL — \$5.00 Per Entry

Six (6) games total pinfall without handicap to determine winners. All monies collected for this pool will be paid out: 1st: 50%, 2nd: 25%, 3rd: 15%, 4th: 10%.

HIGH SINGLE POOL — \$2.00 Per Entry

Scratch and handicapped high single games will be paid. A bowler can win only one (1) prize per entry. All monies collected for this pool will be paid out. The number of winners and the amount of each prize is based on the number of entries.

DOUBLES POOL — \$6.00 Per Team

Both members of a team must bowl on the same shift. Each bowler takes his or her best four (4) games of the tournament. Handicap will be 80% based on a 300 average limit. A bowler can enter only once each time they bowl in the tournament. All monies collected for this pool will be paid out: 1st: 50%, 2nd: 30%, 3rd: 20%.

Hi Everyone,

The last Dudek Lanes Tournament before the End-of-Season Playoffs starts a week from tomorrow. The flyer for the 1st Annual Dudek Classic is attached. This event runs for two weekends with a tournament final round on the second Sunday. This tournament has a 6-game Qualifying Round and the entire event including the Final Round is handicapped (80% based on 160 average).

Also attached is the latest information regarding the End-of-Season Playoffs. The playoff fund went over the \$2000.00 mark after the last tournament and the list of the 23 bowlers who have qualified to participate in the End-of-Season Playoffs and have satisfied the 21-game requirement to keep their playoff spot. There are 7 bowlers who can hit 21 games if they bowl once in the Dudek Classic. There are 12 bowlers who have 13 or 14 games. If these bowlers bowl once and make it the Final Round, you will reach 21 games (Final Round games count towards the game requirement). You can re-enter to be sure.

Thanks to the generosity of Scott Mansi, proprietor of Dudek Lanes, the bowler with the top score for each of the five shifts of the first weekend will receive \$30. The shift times are listed on the attached flyer.
